

Mosques

Birmingham is home to over 150 mosques, with Birmingham Central Mosque being one of the most recognised religious buildings in Birmingham. Two Birmingham mosques have even been named among the first winners in the Beacon Mosque Standards – a new global awards scheme that recognises excellent practices and establishes global standards for Muslim places of worship.

Events

Birmingham's Small Heath Park hosts annual Eid celebrations – the largest gathering of its kind in Europe. Over 140,000 Muslims gathered here in 2018 to celebrate as a community. Birmingham also recently introduced a monthly Muslim market, featuring stalls from over 40 Muslim businesses from around the country.
