HOW WILL IT PREPARE ME FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDY?

Each Pre-Master's programme is tailored according to your chosen subject and includes a range of content-rich modules to equip you with the skills needed for your Master's degree. Below are the mandatory modules included in all of our Pre-Master's programmes.

Interactive Learning Skills and Communication

This module focuses on all of the academic skills needed for success at a UK university – such as time management, presentation skills, researching and referencing.

Critical Thinking

In this module you will learn how to critically assess arguments and evidence from a range of academic sources, as well as gaining an understanding of effective critical reading at postgraduate level.

ICT Skills

This module will help you develop a range of ICT skills for research purposes and postgraduate study – including the presentation of data and using essential tools in Microsoft Word.

Research Methods

In this module you will gain an understanding of research methods and methodologies for postgraduate study, as well as learning how to plan and undertake effective research at postgraduate level.
