Entry requirements

5 GCSE passes at grade 3 (or E if taken prior to 2017), or a minimum of 19 points in the International Baccalaureate or equivalent qualification plus IELTS 5.5 in all band (or equivalent) if secondary school not completed in the UK.

In addition to these entry requirements you will need to provide a personal statement covering the following;

- Please outline why you would like to go into nursing and specifically the stream of nursing for which you have applied
- How your experience and research has contributed to your understanding of the realities and challenges you'll face, both during the course and in the profession
- What it is about your skills, attitudes, values and character that make the profession right for you
- Outline what you think you can offer to the nursing profession and society

On-programme progression requirements

- Successful completion of the foundation programme
- Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) disclosure
- Occupational Health clearance
- Successful Interview with nursing team (group and individual interview)
- Pass literacy and numeracy test
- Pass English Test with the equivalent to IELTS 7.0 (no less than 6.5 in any band)
